This manual explains how to install and update the software.

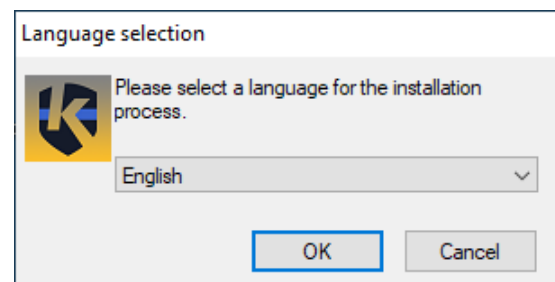
5 INSTALLATION PROCESS

The latest version of Red Alert™ ensures smooth functioning of Kommander™ Builder. If necessary, see Red Alert™ Installation guide.

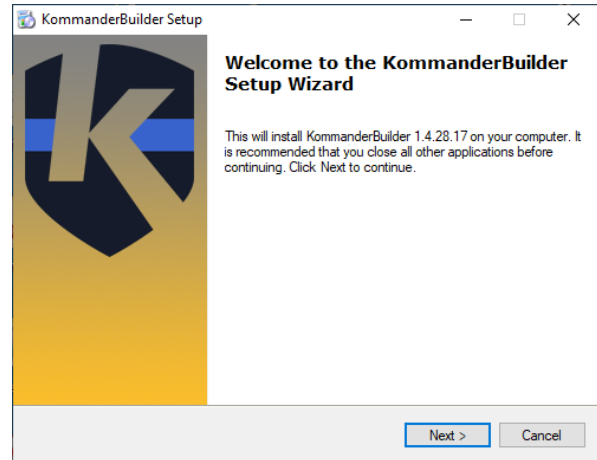
5.2 Installation

1. Download Kommander Builder™ Installer compressed folder (*KommanderBuilderInstaller.zip*).
2. Extract the folder.
3. Double click on *Setup.msi*.
4. Select the preferred installation language.



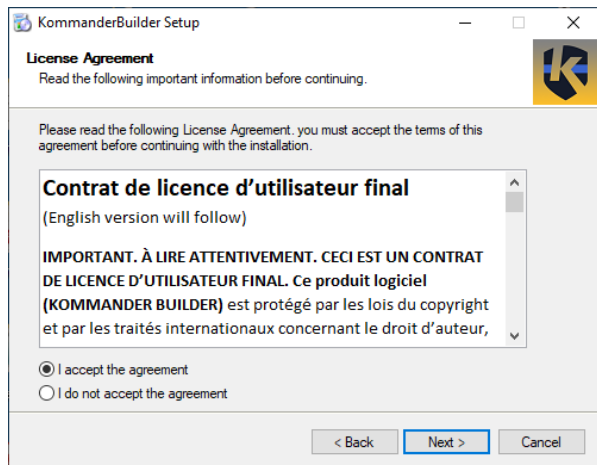
Language Selection Dialog

5. Click *Next*.



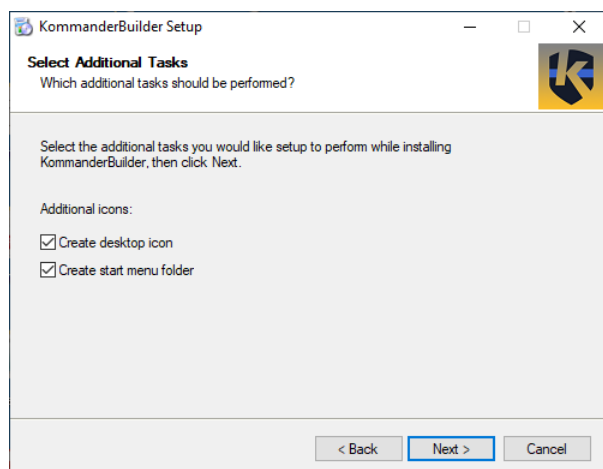

End-User License Agreement

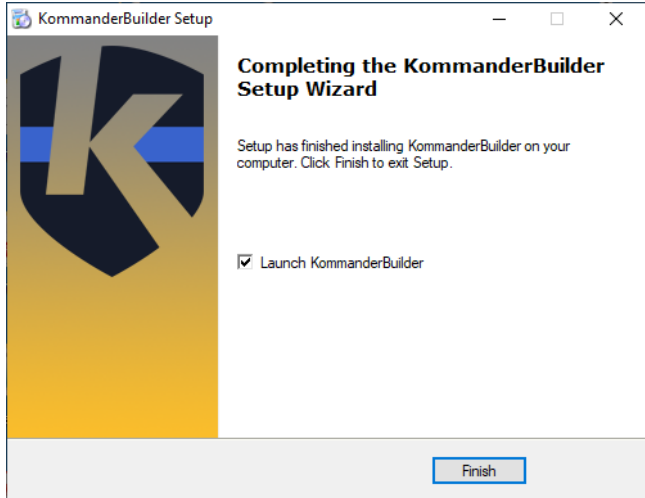
7. Select if you want to add a shortcut for the application on your desktop and if you want to create a folder in the *Start* menu.

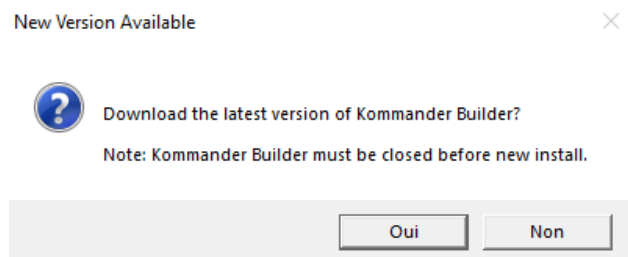
6 UPDATING

6.1 Notification



When a new version of Kommander™ Builder is available, an icon is displayed in the upper right corner of the application.

Click the icon to start downloading the new version: then close Kommander™ Builder and perform the installation as described in the [Installation](#) section. The previous configuration is preserved.

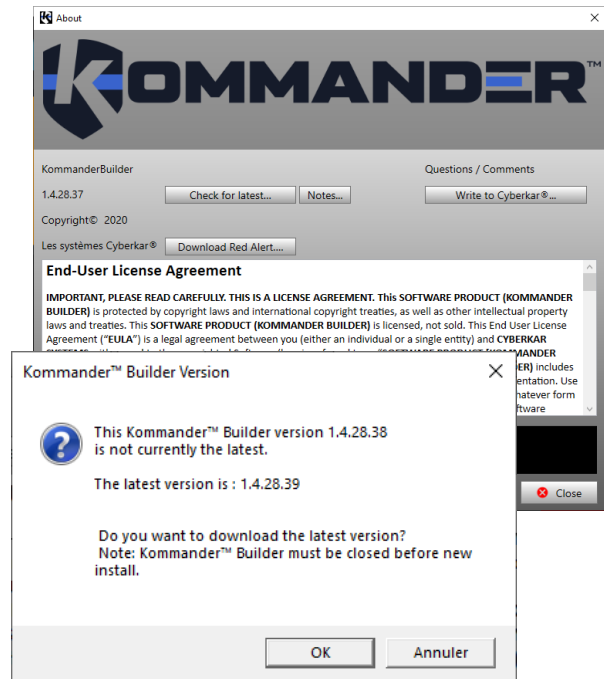


New Version Available Dialog

6.2 Version Check

The *About* option of the *File* menu of the application allows you to display the current version of the configurator and to check if updates are available by using the *Check for latest...* button. When a new version is available, you are invited to download it.
